

Notice of Terminal Change

March 28, 2017

Dear Valued Customer,

We are pleased to announce that Westwood Shipping Lines will be transferring our vessel calls and terminal operations in the Port of Tacoma from Husky Terminal to Olympic Container Terminal (OCT). The OCT firms code is: Y316.

Break-bulk operations: There will be NO changes to the location for breakbulk receipt and delivery or handling procedures (T-7).

Container operations:

Starting on April 10th all empty receipt will occur at OCT. We will continue dispatching empties for certain export bookings out of Husky until April 14th. After April 14th all empty moves (in and out) will be handled at OCT.

The last vessel operations at Husky will occur the week of April 10th.

- The last westbound vessel to work at Husky will be the MV Balsa 002W. Export for this vessel will be received at Husky terminal.
- The last eastbound vessel to work at Husky will be the MV Westwood Columbia 094E and all import cargo from this vessel will be delivered from Husky terminal.

Beginning the week of April 17th all Westwood vessels will begin calling OCT.

- The 1st Eastbound vessel to work at OCT will be the MV Bardu 009E scheduled for April 18/19th. We will deliver all import cargo from this vessel from OCT.
- The MV Westwood Columbia 095W and all future Westbound voyages will be worked at OCT and all export cargo for this vessel and any future vessels will be received at OCT.
